

TPRS End of KS4 outcomes 2018

The outcomes for students attending WBC in the academic year 2017-18 have proved to build on the successes of the previous year. They also confirm that the best outcomes for our children are secured when they are attending WBC, rather than the Alternative Provisions used by the service.

100% of students that attended WBC gained one or more recognised accreditations (Appendix A.17) in 2017/18. This academic year a higher percentage (91%) of students passed the accreditation they were entered for 138/152. A significant improvement compared to 2017 where 117/165 secured accreditations they were entered for (71% pass rate), Appendix 2. This highlights a drastic improvement in the quality assurance outcomes around assessment and progress exercised during the academic year. Overall there were 15% more accreditations in 2018 than 2017 and 20% better pass rate exams entered.

Subject Based Headlines generated from Appendix B

English and Maths accreditation=15 /42=36% (60% of student if they attended WBC full/part timetable).

Maths- In 2018 31% more students passed the course they were entered for than in 2017.

Food, Art and PE retained 100% pass rate.

Appendix C National and local comparison Table

Within the comparison table, we find a positive improvement in pupils leaving with at least one Qualification, as all pupils on the WBC site achieved this goal. Generally, the trends were good: up 2% on the national average for A-C English/Maths and up .5 for A-G. However, there was a disparity between predictions and actual results, that saw a fall of 7.7% and 3% respectively.

There is concern in our use of Alternative provision, as less than half of these pupils left with a qualification.
